#### Communication

You can call the school before 8:10 AM to leave a message or register them as absent through the School Messager App. Without notification, we will call home to confirm the absence as a part of our Safe Arrival Program. #### **School Cash Online**

School Cash Online is our main way to pay for school fees, hot lunch, field trips, school t-shirts, etc. You can sign up with your child's name and birth date to track any expenses and make payments as needed. We will send out information in September regarding this program.

## **Hot Lunch**

Our School Volunteer Committee organizes our Hot Lunch Program. Families can order from the hot lunch options on School Cash Online. A message is always sent to indicate when hot lunch is open for orders.

# **Bus Transportation**

Keeping our students safe is important to us. We follow policies set by Anglophone School District West that allow for only two drop off locations. This keeps our students safe by minimizing confusion. Parents can designate a primary and alternate location within our catchment area to be used as their child's bus stops. This does not allow for occasional drop-offs to birthdays or playdates. If an emergency does arise, please call the office and we can help make arrangements or issue an emergency bus pass.

# Drop Off and Pick Up

Families are welcome to drop off their child between 8:00-8:15 AM at the side doors. We do ask that parents walk their child through the gate to keep them safe from the flow of traffic. Please remember that dogs are not permitted on school property during operational hours which includes drop off and pick up times. After 8:15 AM, we ask parents to walk their child to the front door and sign them in. During regular dismissal, parents can pick up their child at the side door at 2:30 PM. Please meet your child on the inside of the gate to ensure their safety. To pick your child up early, please call the school and come to the front office to sign them out.

### **Locked Door Policy**

We keep our doors locked throughout the day as a safety measure. If you need to come to the school, please use our doorbell and indicate to our staff why you are there. We will happily open the doors for volunteers, drop-offs/pick-ups, or even for those dropping off forgotten items.
